This particular game is nicely suited for “Evansville Day At Busch Stadium” with the connection to Evansville-native Don Mattingly as manager of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Nicknamed “The Hit Man”, Mattingly joined the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2011. Mattingly played for the New York Yankees for 14 years. After retiring in 1995, Mattingly served on the coaching staff for the Yankees until he followed Joe Torre to Los Angeles and became manager of the Dodgers in 2011. The Reitz Memorial High School graduate was selected by the Yankees in the amateur draft. Mattingly emerged as the Yankees’ starting first baseman after a successful rookie season in 1983. He was named to the American League (AL) All-Star team six times, won nine Gold Glove Awards, three Silver Slugger Awards, the 1984 AL batting title, and was the 1985 AL Most Valuable Player. Mattingly served as captain of the Yankees from 1991 through 1995, when he retired as a player.

Banterra’s growth in the Indiana market began when opening a loan production office in Evansville in 2005 and later its first Evansville-area branch in 2007 at 3711 Haley Drive in Newburgh. A second branch was opened in 2009 at 133 Cross Pointe Boulevard, a third branch in 2011 on the west side of Evansville at 705 N. St. Joseph Avenue and fourth branch in 2012 at 435 E. Diamond Avenue.
