Special Olympics is a national charity that promotes acceptance and inclusion of people with intellectual disabilities through year-round sports. Special Olympics – Missouri benefits more than 17,000 Missouri individuals. The Lily Pad is the region’s first prescribed pediatric extended care, accepting children with medical conditions that may otherwise keep them out of typical childcare centers. Evansville’s Dream Center is a charity that assists at-risk youth and their families. Logan’s Promise is an organization started by Logan Brown’s friends and family for scholarships and education on the dangers of drunk driving.
